At what age does a child become an adult? The answer depends on your culture or religion. Here are a few examples.

First, in some North American Indian cultures, a boy becomes a man around the age of 13. At that time, he goes into the woods alone, without food or water, for several days. When he returns safely, he becomes an adult man. Girls become adult women as soon as they are old enough to have babies, also around the age of 12 or 13.

(*) In the Jewish religion, children spend years studying their history and religion.

Then, at age 13 for boys and 12 for girls, they go through an important religious ceremony.

The boys' ceremony is called a bar mitzvah and the girls' is called a bat mitzvah. From that day, they are adults, and they are responsible for their own religious development.

In Japan today, young people become legal adults at age of 20. Each year on the second Monday in January, they celebrate "Coming-of-Age Day," when all the twenty-year-olds in a town are invited to attend a special ceremony. They wear traditional clothes, listen to speeches, and visit with old friends.

Finally, in the United States, the passage into adulthood takes several years. American teenagers look forward to their 16th birthday, because in most states that is the age when they can get a driver's license. The legal age of adulthood is 18. when Americans can vote, get married, and work full-time. (*)

O. K., let's begin our class.

(*) Today, we're talking about smoking in the United States. Specifically, I'm going to talk about the effect that scientific research on smoking has had on our culture.

First, I need to talk about an important term, secondhand smoke. That's smoke from someone else's cigarette. When you're sitting next to someone who is smoking, you are breathing in his or her smoke. Secondhand smoke has about 60 carcinogens (/ka:'sɪnədʒən/) in it. Carcinogens are chemicals that cause cancer. Some medical researchers estimate that as many as 60,000 non-smokers die each year because of secondhand smoke.

I think that you can understand why a lot of non-smokers are angry about this. They have pushed states and cities to ban smoking in all public places. Many places in the United States now have very strict anti-smoking laws for businesses, restaurants, hotels, and bars. All air flights in the United States must be non-smoking flights. (*)

Although there are strict non-smoking laws in many cities across the United States, some regions are clearly stricter than others. The anti-smoking movement tends to be strongest on the West Coast, for example in California, and in the Northeast. Anti-smoking laws vary considerably. In some cities, you can smoke in bars, but not in restaurants. In other cities, you are not allowed to smoke in any public place.
